# Trainings/Workshops

## WORKSHOP ON LEGAL RESEARCH METHODS WITH SAHSOL



In collaboration with the Shaikh Ahmad Hassan School of Law (SAHSOL), the Gad and Birgit Rausing Library, LUMS, conducted a workshop on “Legal Research Methods” to brief the faculty, staff and students about the Law resources and services provided by the Library. The purpose of the session was to familiarise the attendees with e-databases and enable them to fully utilise the resources.

## LAUNCH OF LIBRARY'S SECOND DOCUMENTARY

The Library launched its second documentary, which entailed views and comments from the LUMS faculty and enrolled students. The primary goal of the documentary was to promote a culture of reading among the LUMS community and create awareness about the resources and services currently offered by the Library. ## THE ANNUAL BOOK FAIR AT LUMS

## ACCESS TO THE SOUTH ASIA ARCHIVE



Trial access to the South Asia Archive was given to the LUMS community till March 10, 2020. The South Asia Archive provides an extensive resource for students and scholars across the disciplines of Humanities and Social Sciences. Focusing on South Asia, the Archive contains serial and non-serial materials, including reports, rare books, and journal runs from noteworthy and rare publications. The documents in the Archive are truly interdisciplinary, reflecting the varied range of knowledge production in Colonial and early Post-Colonial India, in fields including Culture and Society, Industry and Economy, Science, Technology and Medicine, Urban Planning and Administration, and Politics and Law.

## Delegations

The chief librarian, acquisition head of Information Technology University, and head of e-libraries Lahore visited the LUMS Library to explore the innovations and services it offers. They appreciated the Library staff's enthusiasm to provide good services to the LUMS community.

## Trainings and Workshops

### INFORMATION LITERACY / RESEARCH SKILLS ENHANCEMENT SESSION

The main topics covered in the session focused on using EndNote to import citations from e-databases, developing a personal library of references, searching through EndNote, generating in-text references and bibliographies, and how to use citations while writing.

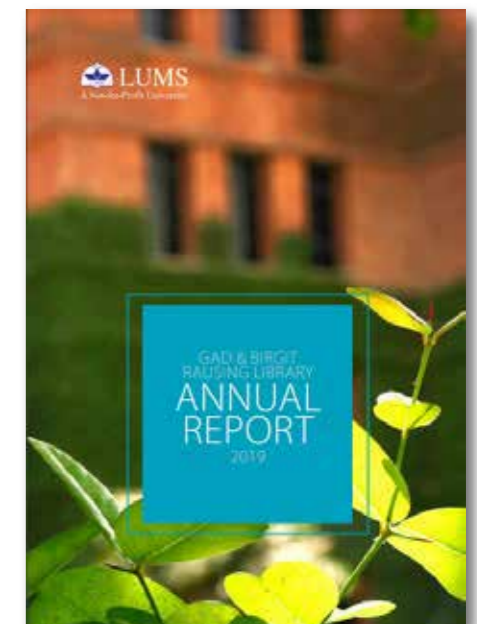


## STAY HOME—GO DIGITAL

## SIMILARITY REPORTS AND PLAGIARISM DETECTION CERTIFICATES

During the critical situation of COVID-19, the Library has been delivering the best online services 24/7 to its community. Plagiarism detection is one of the unique and focused services of library professionals to the LUMS community. As exams commence, the students rush to the Library to check plagiarism in their research projects, essays, thesis, etc., and then request for plagiarism certificates, which is a necessary part of thesis submission. Library staff generated about 7308 similarity reports during the month of May and got appreciation from the LUMS faculty and students.

## LIBRARY CLEARANCE PROCESS

The library staff remains active and vigilant while doing the clearance of students. Graduating students need to get clearance from all departments, including the Library. The Library clearance process involves receiving back all Library materials from the students, fine calculation, etc. Our professional staff performed this activity very smoothly, coordinating with other departments and students during the pandemic.

It also promotes the creation and dissemination of essential Humanities and Social Science resources through collaboration with libraries, publishers, and scholars worldwide.

## ACCESS TO PASSPORT BY EUROMONITOR COLLECTION

Passport is Euromonitor International's global market analysis software platform, which analyses the industry in countries worldwide. It provides access to more than 115 million internationally standardised statistics. It enables users to gain an unbiased view of industry sectors, country markets, and companies using research from our analysts, leveraging their knowledge of the local market, fluency in the local language, and access to the best research sources.



## ACCESS TO GETABSTRACT

The getAbstract is an online library offering 20,000+ text and audio summaries of business books. The company's expert editorial team finds finds, rates, and summarises relevant knowledge to help people make better decisions in business. Around 15,000 summaries are currently available in English, German, Spanish, Russian, Chinese, French, and Portuguese.

## HEC GRANT FOR THE LUMS LIBRARY

The Library has been awarded a grant of PKR 1.898 Million for the purchase of books and subscription of journals under HEC's "Library Support Programme". The grant was based on the number of PhD faculty members teaching at the University. The Library purchased 286 books against this grant, and reimbursement has been received from HEC. The books purchased covered subjects such as engineering, mathematics, computer science, business management, economics, and social studies, etc.

### WEBEX TRAINING SESSION ON SCOPUS DATABASE

The Gad and Birgit Rausing Library, in collaboration with HEC/A&J Def Tek consultants, conducted WebEx training sessions for the faculty members and LUMS students on the SCOPUS, Science Direct, and Mendeley. Customer Consultant - Research Intelligence, South Asia Elsevier, of SCOPUS provided the training through video conferencing on the silent features of the Scopus, Science Direct, and citation management tool Mendeley.

## INFORMATION LITERACY / RESEARCH SKILLS ENHANCEMENT SESSION

The second session on "Manage Your Research with EndNote" was conducted using an online zoom link. The main topics covered in the session were using EndNote to import citations from e-databases, developing a personal library of references, searching through EndNote, generating in-text references and bibliographies, and using citations while writing.

## ACCESS TO ART FULL-TEXT

Art Full-Text is a comprehensive resource for art information featuring full-text articles from more than 300 periodicals dating back to 1995, high-quality indexing and abstracting of over 600 publications dating as far back as 1984, including 280 peer-reviewed journals, as well as indexing and abstracting of over 13,000 art dissertations. Indexing of almost 200,000 art reproductions provides examples of styles and art movements, including works by emerging artists. The database covers fine, decorative, and commercial art, folk art, photography, film, and architecture, and also includes a database-specific thesaurus.

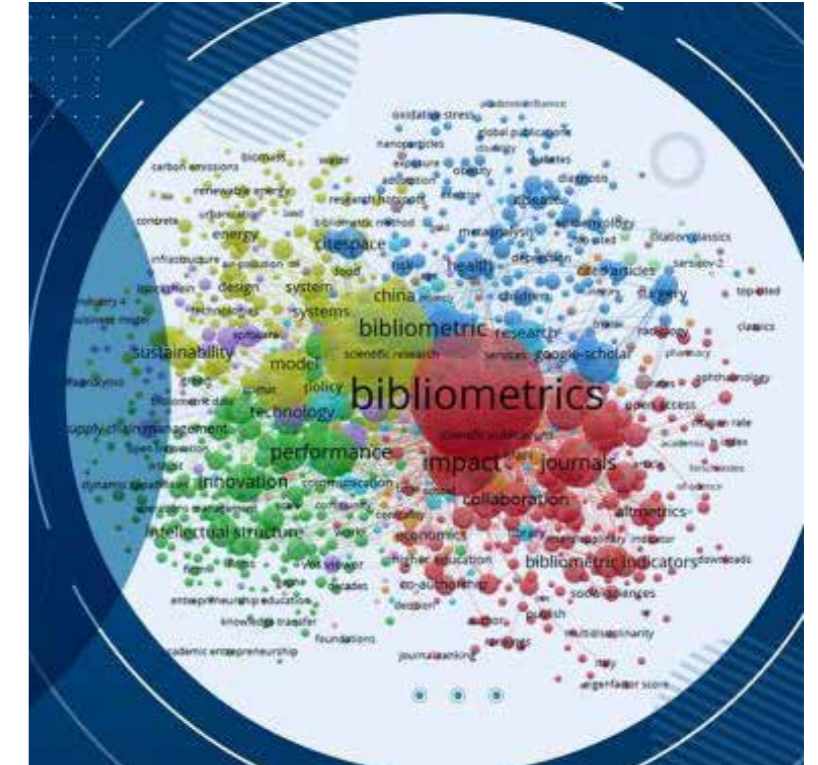

Featured databases include IBSS, Sociological Abstracts, and Worldwide Political Science Abstracts. Together, they provide abstracts, indexing, and full-text coverage of journal articles, books, book chapters, dissertations, working papers, and more.
